APPLICATION FOR A FELLOWSHIP IN THE NATURAL SCIENCES

* The applicant must include this **completed application form**, **two letters of recommendation** (neither of which should be from the sponsoring professor), a **proposal of not more than five pages** that contains a clear statement of the work to be undertaken (including its objectives, intellectual merit, relation to the present state of knowledge in the field, and experimental methods and procedures), a **detailed budget**, and a **personal statement** describing the applicant's academic background, scientific interests and goals, suitability for field or laboratory experiences, and past research experiences. Incomplete and/or late applications will NOT be considered.

*If your project will require approval by the **Institutional Review Board** (your research involves the use of human subjects or materials), the **Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee** (your research involves the housing or handling of vertebrate animals), or the **Safety Officer** (your research involves the use of hazardous chemicals or agents), a detailed plan to receive these approvals must be part of your fellowship application. Similar details must be provided for field-based projects requiring permitting from state/federal agencies or site access agreements. Approvals can take some time to acquire, so interested students should start early.
